TAMBUNAN DISTRICT COUNCIL (PIG CONTROL) BY-LAWS 1964 (G.N.L 44 of 1964)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Tambunan District Council has made the following by-laws:

Title.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Tambunan District Council (Pig Control) By-laws 1964.

Pigs to be kept penned.

2. All persons keeping pigs within one mile of any public road, jeep track or bridle path shall keep such pigs penned.

Penalty.

3. Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for a first offence and of one hundred ringgit for any subsequent offence.

Revocation.

4. The Pig Control (Tambunan Area) By-laws 1957 is hereby revoked.
