CATTLE AND GRAZING ORDINANCE, 1914
(No. 26 of 1914)

THE BRANDING (KOTA BELUD LOCAL AUTHORITY AREA)
FEES RULES, 1953

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 23 of the Cattle and Grazing Ordinance, 1914 [*No. 26 of 1914.*] and all other powers thereunto him enabling, His Excellency the Governor has made the following rules:-

1. These rules may be cited as the Branding (Kota Belud Local Authority Area) Fees, 1953.
2. A fee of fifty cents shall be paid by the owner in respect of the branding in the Kota Belud Local Authority Area of any cattle with the District brand by the person duly appointed by the District Officer to carry out such branding.
3. The person duly appointed by the District Officer to carry out the branding of cattle with the District brand shall be entitled to one half of any fee paid under Rule 2.
