

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961  
(No. 11 of 1961)**

**KINABATANGAN DISTRICT COUNCIL  
(TAMU) BY-LAWS 1969  
(G.N.L 27 of 1969)**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Kinabatangan District Council has made the following by-laws:

**Title and commencement.**

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Kinabatangan District Council (Tamu) By-laws 1969 and shall apply to all tamu established in the Kinabatangan District Council area.

**Interpretation.**

2. In these By-laws-

“tamu” means an open-air market established by the Council.

**Licence.**

3. No person shall sell any commodity in any tamu without a licence which may be issued by the Chairman of the Council in his discretion, and subject to such conditions as he may see fit to impose.

**Appeal.**

4. Any person whose application for a licence has been refused may appeal to the Council at its next meeting and the decision of the Council shall be final.

**Fees.**

5. The following fees shall be paid for licences issued under by-law 4-

	RM <i>per month or part thereof</i>
(a) for a licence to sell from a stall, cloth and general merchandise of all kinds not being of local manufacture	10.00
(b) for a licence to sell, otherwise than from a stall, cloth and general merchandise of all kinds not being of local manufacture ... ..	5.00
(c) for a licence to sell, otherwise than from a stall, fruits, vegetable, dried or fresh fish, betel-nut, salt, cakes and other local products ... ..	Free
(d) for a licence to sell any other commodity ... ..	5.00

**Tamu Master.**

6. The Council may appoint any person to be Tamu Master for any tamu, who shall be charged with the keeping of order in and the general management of the tamu.

**Penalty.**

7. Any person who –

- (a) sells any commodity in any tamu without a licence issued under these By-laws; or
- (b) takes or attempts to take into any tamu any intoxicating liquor; or

- (c) has in his possession in any tamu any firework, firearm or offensive weapon;  
or
- (d) being a licence holder fails to comply with any lawful direction of the Tamu Master,

shall be guilty of an offence against these By-laws and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty-five ringgit and on a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty ringgit.
