

**RURAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE
(Cap. 132)**

**KOTA BELUD DISTRICT COUNCIL
(CATTLE AUCTION) BY-LAWS, 1958
(G.N.S. 110 of 1958)**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, the Kota Belud District Council has made the following By-laws:-

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Kota Belud District Council (Cattle Auction) By-laws, 1958, and shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1958.
2. (1) No cattle for export from the district of Kota Belud shall be brought except at an auction.

(2) Such auction shall, where practicable, be held every Saturday at such time and upon such conditions as may be prescribed by the District Council.

(3) In these By-laws the word "cattle" includes buffaloes but not horses, ponies, goats or sheep.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of by-law 2, the President of the District Council may in his discretion at any time permit an owner to export any of his cattle.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of these By-laws shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred ringgit.
