

LABOUR (DOMESTIC SERVICE) RULES, 1957.

(G.N.S. 143 of 1957)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 100 of the Labour Ordinance [*Cap. 67.*] and all other powers thereunto him enabling, the Governor in Council has made the following rules:-

1. These rules may be cited as the Labour (Domestic service) Rules, 1957, and shall come into operation on 1st January, 1958.

2. The following provisions of the Labour Ordinance [*Cap. 67.*] shall apply to all domestic servants –

Chapter I (the whole), Chapter II (the whole), Chapter IV (the whole), Chapter V (the whole), Chapter VIII (the whole), sections 83-95 (inclusive), Chapter XII (the whole), sections 101, 102, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 118, 119, 120 (excluding paragraph (c)), Chapter XVI (the whole).

3. For the purpose of the interpretation of these provisions to domestic servants, the expression “worker” where used therein shall be deemed to refer to “domestic servant”.
