THE NORTH BORNEO (COMPENSATION AND RETIRING BENEFITS) ORDER-IN-COUNCIL, 1963

In pursuance of paragraph 21 of the Schedule to the North Borneo (Compensation and Retiring Benefits) Order-in-Council, 1963 [*G.N. No. S 144 of 1963.*], it is hereby notified for general information that the Governments of the United Kingdom and Malaysia have agreed that the Schedule to the said Order shall have effect with effect from 23rd August, 1968 in relation to any entitled officer as if paragraph 2 (4) were deleted and the following paragraphs were substituted therefor:

“(4) Each person who is serving as an entitled officer shall be entitled to additional compensation (notwithstanding that such additional compensation when added to the compensation to which he is entitled under sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph may exceed twelve thousand pounds) to be assessed on each occasion on which his compensation is re-assessed or finally assessed under sub-paragraph (3) of this paragraph and calculated on each such occasion by multiplying by decimal point 10 one-twelfth of the amount of his annual pensionable emoluments at the date taken for calculation of his compensation when it is re-assessed or finally assessed, as the case may be, for each completed month in the period beginning at the date by reference to which his compensation was last assessed and ending at the date by reference to which his compensation is being assessed.”
