THE NORTH BORNEO AND SARAWAK (ALTERATION OF
BOUNDARIES) ORDER IN COUNCIL, 1962

Made - - - 26th February, 1962

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 26th day of February, 1962

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter and to describe more precisely part of the boundary between the Colonies of North Borneo and Sarawak in the area east of Brunei Bay :

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance, of the powers conferred upon Her by the Colonial Boundaries Act, 1895 (a) [58 & 59 Vict. c. 34.], and all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :-

Citation and revocation.

1. - (1) This Order may be cited as the North Borneo and Sarawak (Alteration of Boundaries) Order in Council, 1962.

(2) The North Borneo and Sarawak (Alteration of Boundaries) Order in Council, 1960 (b) [G.N. No. S 164 of 1960.], is revoked.

New description of boundary east of Brunei Bay.

2. - (2) Commencing at the mouth of the Bengkulit River the boundary between the Colony of North Borneo and the Colony of Sarawak shall run in a southerly direction following the true right or eastern bank of the river for a distance of approximately 70 chains to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/3558, and thence on a bearing of $110^{\circ} 27' 30''$ for 257.3 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/3557, and thence on a bearing of $118^{\circ} 26' 40''$ for 2742.4 links to a point, which point together with all further points hereinafter mentioned is marked by a belian peg, and thence on a bearing of $118^{\circ} 28' 00''$ for 2453.1 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $118^{\circ} 53' 10''$ for 2567.1 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $119^{\circ} 21' 00''$ for 1885.3 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2570, and thence on a bearing of $120^{\circ} 40' 40''$ for 1509.4 links to a square boundary stone marked 47, which stone is situated 2359.4 links on a bearing of $219^{\circ} 12' 40''$ from a North Borneo Trigonometrical Station marked 66/852 situated on Bukit Suai, and thence on a bearing of $95^{\circ} 31' 10''$ for 4252.4 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2534 and thence on a bearing of $95^{\circ} 33' 20''$ for 883.1 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2536, and thence on a bearing $95^{\circ} 34' 20''$ for 3359.0 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $95^{\circ} 30' 50''$ for 3223.4 links to a square boundary stone marked 32, which stone

forms the North Borneo Trigonometrical Station known as Binjai, and thence on a bearing of $99^{\circ} 44' 20''$ for 3018.5 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $99^{\circ} 45' 10''$ for 3322.2 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $99^{\circ} 44' 50''$ for 3237.5 links to a square boundary stone marked 46, which stone is situated about half way between the village of Sindumin in North Borneo and the village of Merapok in Sarawak and is 15.9 links on a bearing of $149^{\circ} 51' 00''$ from a North Borneo Trigonometrical Station marked 10/393 and known as Sindumin, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 55' 50''$ for 2036.0 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2540, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 54' 10''$ for 2167.3 links to a point and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 53' 10''$ for 386.4 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 48' 20''$ for 3704.8 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 50' 20''$ for 1244.8 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2543, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 45' 30''$ for 2019.9 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 36' 00''$ for 1839.7 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2544, and thence on a bearing of $65^{\circ} 55' 00''$ for 3182.7 links to a point, and thence on a bearing of $66^{\circ} 16' 30''$ for 3343.3 links to a sunken concrete mark numbered 5/2546, and thence on a bearing of $66^{\circ} 07' 50''$ for 2045.4 links to a square boundary stone marked 50, which stone is situated 37.0 links on a bearing of $235^{\circ} 48' 00''$ from a North Borneo Trigonometrical Station marked 11/440 situated on Bukit Kawang.

(2) For the purposes of the foregoing description of the boundary –

- (a) bearings are grid bearings on the Borneo Rectified Skew Orthomorphic Projection; and
- (b) distances have been obtained by computing projection distances from the rectangular co-ordinates on the Borneo Rectified Skew Orthomorphic Projection of the boundary stones, marks and points mentioned in the said description.
