

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961  
(No. 11 Of 1961)**

**PAPAR DISTRICT COUNCIL  
(PUBLIC WEIGH-BRIDGES AND WEIGHING MACHINES)  
BY-LAWS 1980**

**(G.N.L 23 of 1980)**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Papar District Council has made the following by-laws:

**1. Citation.**

These by-laws may be cited as the Papar District Council (Public Weigh-Bridges and Weighing Machines) By-laws 1980 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1981.

**2. Licence.**

No person shall install any public weigh-bridges or weighing machines in any place except in accordance with a licence granted by the Council.

**3. Application for licence.**

An application for a licence shall be in writing and shall specify the premises on which the applicant proposes to carry on the business.

**4. Grant of licence.**

The Council may, in its absolute discretion, grant or refuse a licence, or grant a licence subject to such conditions as it thinks fit.

**5. Duration of licence.**

All licences shall, subject to the provisions of these By-laws, expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which it is granted.

**6. Fee.**

The annual fee for a licence shall be thirty-six ringgit.

**7. Penalty.**

Any person who contravenes any of provisions of these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of not more than one hundred ringgit or two weeks imprisonment in default of payment.
