

**PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE 1960
(No. 7 of 1960)**

**PENAMPANG DISTRICT COUNCIL
(SLAUGHTERHOUSES) BY-LAWS 1978
(G.N.L 55 of 1978)**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 66 and 75 of the Public Health Ordinance 1960, the Kota Kinabalu Rural District Council has made the following by-laws:

Title and commencement.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Penampang District Council (Slaughterhouses) By-laws 1978 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1978.

Approval of slaughterhouses.

2. No place shall be used as a slaughterhouse unless approved by the Council. Such approval may be withdrawn at any time if in the opinion of the Council the premises are found to be unfit for use as a slaughterhouse.

Cleanliness.

3. Every slaughterhouse together with the yards, pens, and appurtenances thereto shall be kept in the complete repair and in an efficient sanitary condition and all filth or refuse shall be removed forthwith by the slaughterer to the satisfaction of the Council.

Disposal of refuse.

4. All filth or refuse shall be deposited and disposed of only in such place and in such manner as the Council may from time to time direct.

Diseased animals.

5. (1) No diseased animals shall be admitted for slaughter, and the Council may refuse to allow the slaughter of any animal or the dressing of any carcass which by reasons of emaciation is unfit for human.

(2) The Council shall have power to examine any carcass or any animals intended to be slaughtered.

(3) On such examination the Council may order any animal found to be unfit for human consumption to be killed, and may order any carcass so found to be so disposed of as to prevent it being used for human.

6. Detention.

Only animals brought for slaughter shall be admitted to pens at any slaughterhouse. The Council may regulate the period for which such animal may be kept therein.

Fees.

7. The following fees shall be levied —

	RM <i>per head</i>
For the slaughter of cattle/buffalo	25.00
For the slaughter of pigs	10.00
For the slaughter of goat/sheep	5.00

Penalty.

8. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of not more than one hundred ringgit or one week imprisonment in default of payment.

Repeal.

9. Part XV of the Kota Kinabalu Town Board (General) By-laws 1956 [G.N.S. 29/56.] made applicable to the Kota Kinabalu Rural District Council under G.N. No. S 69 of 1958 is hereby repealed.
