(Cap. 132)

PIG CONTROL (KENINGAU AREA) BY-LAWS, 1956
(G.N.S. 48 of 1956)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 56 and paragraph (7) of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, the Resident, Interior Residency, has made the following By-laws:-

1. These By-laws shall be known as the Pig Control (Keningau Area) By-laws, 1956 and shall apply in that area of Keningau District to the West of the Pegalan River.
2. All persons keeping pigs shall keep such pigs continually penned.
3. Any person failing to comply with such by-laws shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for the first offence and of one hundred ringgit for the second or any subsequent offence.
