

**RURAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE
(Cap. 132)**

**PAPAR LOCAL AUTHORITY
(PIG CONTROL) BY-LAWS 1957**

(G.N.S 14 of 1957)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph 7 of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Papar Local Authority has made the following by-laws which have been approved by the Resident:

1. Title and Application.

These by-laws shall be known as Pig Control (Papar Area) By-laws 1957 and shall apply throughout the Papar Local Authority Area.

2. Pigs to be continuously penned.

All person keeping pigs shall keep such pigs continuously penned.

3. Penalty.

Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for the first offence and of one hundred ringgit for the second or any subsequent offence.
