PIG CONTROL (TUARAN AREA) BY-LAWS 1956
(G.N.S. 76 of 1956)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (a) of subsection (1) of section 56 and paragraph (7) of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, the Resident, West Coast Residency, has made the following by-laws:

Title and application.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Pig Control (Tuaran Area) By-laws 1956 and shall apply in those areas lying within a quarter mile of either side of the following paths and road -

- (1) Bolong Bridle Path;
- (2) Tajau Bridle Path;
- (3) Tanjong Bridle Path; and
- (4) Mengkabong Road.

Pigs to be continuously penned.

2. All persons keeping pigs shall keep such pigs continuously penned.

Penalty.

3. Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be liable to a fine of twenty-five ringgit for a first offence and to a fine of one hundred ringgit for a second or any subsequent offence.
