

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961
(No. 11 of 1961)
RANAU DISTRICT COUNCIL (TAMU) BY-LAWS 1962
(G.N.L 14 of 1962)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section 50 and by section 52 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Ranau District Council has made the following by-laws:

1. Title and application.

These by-laws may be cited as the Ranau District Council (Tamu) By-laws 1962 and shall apply to all tamu established in Ranau District Council area.

2. Interpretation.

In these by-laws, the word "tamu" means an open market declared by the Council to be a tamu by notice posted on the Notice Board of the Council.

3. Licence.

No person shall sell any commodity in any tamu except with a licence which may be issued by the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of the Council subject to such conditions as he may impose:

Provided that no licence issued under this by-law may be transferred from one tamu to another tamu within the area of the Ranau District.

4. Appeal.

Any person whose application for a licence has been refused or who is aggrieved by the conditions imposed on his licence may appeal to the Council at its next meeting and the decision of the Council thereon shall be final.

5. Fees.

The following fees shall be paid for licences issued under by-law 3-

6. Tamu Master.

The Council may, in writing, appoint any person to be a Tamu Master for a tamu who shall be charged with the keeping of order in and the general management of the tamu.

7. Penalty.

Any person who-

- (a) sells or exposes for sale any commodity in a tamu without a licence or who contravenes the conditions of a licence issued under these By-laws; or
- (b) takes into a tamu intoxicating liquor; or
- (c) has in his possession in a tamu any firework, firearm or any offensive weapon; or
- (d) fails to comply with any lawful direction of the Tamu Master,

shall be guilty of an offence against these By-laws and shall be liable to a fine of two hundred fifty ringgit.

7A. Compounding of offences.

- (i) Notwithstanding any provision of the By-laws, any officer of the Council duly authorised in writing by the Council may in his discretion compound any offences under these By-laws or any contravention of the conditions of the licence issued by collecting from a person reasonably suspected of having committed the offence a sum not exceeding one hundred ringgit.
- (ii) On payment of such sum, no further proceedings shall be taken against the person in respect of such offence.
- (iii) The payment shall be evidenced by a receipt issued by the officer so authorised to compound the offence.
