

The Rubber Dealers Rules.

(SECTION 7.)

[1ST JULY, 1946.]

1. These Rules may be cited as the Rubber Dealers Rules.

2. Every person licensed to purchase rubber shall deposit the sum of \$1,000 to serve as security for the proper observance of the terms of his licence.

3. All books of account kept by licensed dealers shall be written in English or Romanised Malay.
