

**THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, 1961**  
**(Ordinance No. 11 of 1961)**

**SANDAKAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL RATES ORDER, 1987**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 82 of the Local Government Ordinance, 1961 [*Ord. No. 11 of 1961.*], and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Sandakan Municipal Council hereby makes the following Order:-

**Citation.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Sandakan Municipal Council Rates Order, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 1987.

**Rates for 1987.**

2. The Sandakan Municipal Council hereby prescribes the following annual rates on rateable property situated in the area specified hereunder for the year 1987:-

- (a) The Urban Division of the Sandakan Municipality delineated and edged in green on the Deposited Plan No. 07127909 dated 15th December, 1982:-

| (ii) Sewerage .....        |     | Four per cent of the rateable value of all rateable property any part of which is situated within 100 feet of a public sewer and which is, in the opinion of the Council, practicable to connect with a public sewer.   |
- (b) The Suburban Division of the Sandakan Municipality delineated and edged in purple on the Deposited Plan No. 07127909 dated 15th December, 1982:-

- (i) General purposes ..... (a) Six per cent of the rateable value of all rateable property and in addition two per cent of the rateable value of multi-storey residential or residential cum commercial buildings the staircases and gully traps of which are cleaned or otherwise swept by the Council's workmen. Further an additional two per cent of the rateable value of multi-storey buildings serviced by refuse cutes dust-bins.
- (b) Five per cent of the rateable value of all undeveloped titled lands.
- (ii) Sewerage ..... Two and a half per cent of the rateable value of all rateable property any part of which is situated within 100 feet of a public sewer and which is, in the opinion of the Council practicable to connect with a public sewer.
