

CHAPTER 137.

STAMP ORDINANCE

Registration of documents.

83. (1) Any document for which no form of registration has been expressly prescribed by any written law may be registered by depositing a certified duplicate copy of the same in the office of a magistrate in any district on payment of the prescribed fee.

(2) Any document may be signed before a magistrate, and if he is satisfied that the proper stamp duty has been paid the magistrate may attest the signature on payment of the prescribed fee.

(3) A copy of any document deposited under the provisions of subsection (1) may be presented at the office of the magistrate and, upon payment of the prescribed fee, may after verification be certified by the magistrate or clerk of court as an office copy.

(4) An office copy of any document when certified under subsection (3) shall, without further proof, be sufficient evidence of the contents of such document and of the registration thereof under the provisions of this section.
