

**LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE, 1961
(No. 11 of 1961)**

**TELUPID DISTRICT COUNCIL INSTRUMENT 2019
(G.N.S. 1 of 2020)**

INSTRUMENT issued by the Yang di-Pertua Negeri under section 3 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961 [No. 11 of 1961].

1. This Instrument may be cited as the Telupid District Council Instrument 2019.

2. In this Instrument -

“Council” means the Telupid District Council established by clause 3;

“Member” means a member of the Council appointed under clause 6;

“Ordinance” means the Local Government Ordinance 1961 [No. 11 of 1961].

3. It is hereby established a Council to be known as the Telupid District Council.

4. (1) The limits of the area under the jurisdiction of the Council are as prescribed in the First Schedule.

(2) The area set out in the Second Schedule is declared to be a township to be known as Telupid Township.

(3) The area set out in the First Schedule is declared as rating area shall be subjected to rates as prescribed by the order made under section 82 of the Ordinance.

5. (1) The seal of the Council shall be the following device:

A circle with the words "Telupid District Council" around the circumference.

(2) Notwithstanding until such time that a seal capable of reproducing the said device can be procured, a rubber stamp bearing the inscription "Telupid District Council" may be used in lieu of such seal.

6. The Council shall be composed of the District Officer of Telupid and not more than eighteen members to be appointed by the Minister.

7. All members of the Council shall be appointed for a period of not exceeding two years.

8. The Chairman of the Council shall be the District Officer of Telupid and the Vice Chairman shall be elected by all the members of the Council from amongst the members.

9. (1) The Council's office shall be situated at the Telupid District Council's office building.

(2) Meetings of the Council shall be held in the office of the Council.

10. The Council shall hold not less than four ordinary meetings each year.

11. (1) The Chairman may at any time and shall, at the request in writing of not less than one third of the members stating the object of the meeting, call a special meeting of the Council, and the day fixed for such meeting shall be within fourteen days of the presentation of such request.

(2) The notice of any special meeting shall specify the object of the meeting, and no other subject than those specified in such notice shall be discussed at such meeting.

12. The quorum at an ordinary or special meeting of the Council shall be two-thirds of the members.

13. (1) Notice of meeting and place of every meeting of the Council shall be served on every member either personally or by leaving the same at his usual place of residence or his business address not less than 24 hours before such meeting.

(2) Provided that the accidental omission to serve such notice on any member shall not effect the validity of any meeting.

14. The Council may appoint any Government officer or person with the professional of special qualifications to any committee established under subsection 27(1) of the Ordinance.

15. (1) In addition to those functions conferred upon the Council by the Ordinance or by any other law for the time being in force, the Council-

- (a) shall perform the functions specified in paragraph (49) of subsection 49(1) of the Ordinance;
- (b) Shall provide for the burial of paupers in accordance with the religion or custom of the deceased as specified in paragraph (26) of subsection 49(1) of the Ordinance;
- (c) Shall perform all the functions specified in paragraphs (23), (23B) and (46) of subsection 49(1) of the Ordinance;
- (d) Shall keep clean all roads, streets and all other public places of which the Council has general control and care;
- (e) may perform all the functions specified in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13), (14), (15), (16), (17), (18), (19), (19A), (20), (21), (22), (24), (25), (27), (28), (29), (30), (34), (35), (36), (37), (38), (39), (40), (41), (42), (43), (44), (45), (47), (48), (50), (51), (52), (53), (54), (55), (57), (58), (59), (60), (61), (62), (64A), (66) (67), (68), (69), (70), (71), (72) and (73) of subsection 49(1) of the Ordinance; and
- (f) may regulate and control stopping and parking of vehicles in any vehicles park established by the Council or under its control;

2. The functions specified in subclauses (1)(c), (d) and (f) shall not be exercisable in any part of the area which is not within the Telupid Township.
